Spelling – this week we would like you to do the following...

Unit 9: adding the suffix –ing (page 34 – 36) and

Unit 10: j sound (page 37 – 39)

Remember to practise and recall the spelling rules from the ones we have done so far...don't forget to practise those words!

Maths – we are going to learn to tell the Time.

Last week, you to make your own homemade clock. They were all lovely...such a variety of colours and styles.



Now you have a clock...let's tell the time.

Last week you used the powerpoint to recall o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. You need to be able to recognise all of them. You need to be able to draw on a blank clock, read a time given on a clock and write using words eg half past two.

This week you are going to have a go at telling the time to 5 minutes. I have a time instruction sheet for parents/carers on how to teach time. The most important bit is – do it in small chunks. If you think of all the elements required to tell the time it can be confusion for a 6/7 year. Short burst of 15 mins max on this will help them learn to tell the time. I have added XXXX for you to use as a guide.

Topic – Around the World

This week we turn our attention to **EUROPE.**

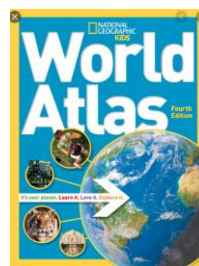
Please do the work in the School Closure book or if you have created one a folder/scrapbook from home. As I said last week....up to you!

Or perhaps an atlas.

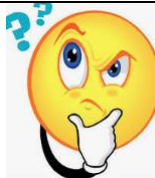


- **Europe** – where is it on a map (use a globe, atlas or online)

What would you like to find out about it?
- Make a famous food dish for lunch – a greek salad
- Draw their flag and colour it correctly
- What money do they use?

Writing –

- What facts can you tell us about the country you have chosen.
- Write down any fun or interesting facts you can find out in books/online about your country.
- Write about their weather
- Write about their famous landmarks
- Do they have any specific customs in that country?
- Can you tell us something we don't know about your chosen country – we look forward to hearing from you!

Remember to read the information and then write it in your own words....using your best joined up handwriting!
