**Incorrect**

**Possible corrections: 19 is 1 more than 18;  
18 is 1 less than 19; 17 is 1 less than 18.**



At Tim's party there are 12 girls. There is 1 more boy than there are girls. How many boys are there?



**There are 13 boys.**

The pass the parcel present has 18 layers. One is torn off. How many layers are left?

**There are 17 layers left.**

Tim has 17 cards. He gets 1 more. How many does he now have?

**Tim has 18 cards.**
