## Year 6 Spelling Rules Covered in Read Write Inc

## Units 1-6

- words containing the letter string ough (pronounced different ways) eg: enough, plough, doughnut, thoroughly
- common words that adults find difficult to spell eg: communicate, harass, occur, occupy
- homophones and other words often confused eg: principle/principal, weary/wary, proceed/precede
- doubled consonants where a suffix has been added eg: admittance, beginning, referring
- the sh sound spelt ti or ci eg: direction, delicious, ancient
- silent letters eg: calm, autumn, knee, solemn, whistle
- spelling ie/ei (i before e except after c) eg: perceive, niece, achieve
- hyphens to attach a prefix to a root word eg: co-operate, re-enter
- words ending in -ible and -able eg: terrible, reliable, responsible, possibly
- common mistakes eg: it's/its, your/you're, whose/who's
- plural nouns eg: bonus...bonuses, dictionary...dictionaries, potato...potatoes, loaf...loaves
- confusing near homophone nouns and verbs eg: advice(noun)/advise (verb), licence (noun)/license (verb)

- silent letter b eg: thumb, numb
- words containing the letter string ough eg: fought, nought, cough, enough
- homophones eg: heard/herd, cereal/serial
- words ending -able eg: breakable, reliable, adorable
- silent letter t eg: glisten, listen, rustle, whistle
- words ending -ibly and -ably eg: suitably, terribly
- words ending in -ent eg: frequent, dependent


## Units 7-14

- words ending in -ence eg: absence, dependence
- the ee sound spelt ei eg: receive, caffeine
- homophones and other words easily confused eg: affect/effect, accept/except
- words ending -cious (pronounced -shus) eg: spacious, precious
- words ending -tious (pronounced -shus) eg: ambitious, nutritious
- words ending in -cial or tial eg: special, initial, essential

- im-added to root words beginning with $m$ or $p$ eg: impatient, immortal
- -ous (suffix) eg: dangerous
- -ly (suffix) eg: suddenly
- -ture (words ending in ...) eg: temptation, exploration
- -ation (added to verbs to form nouns) eg: temptation, exploration
- c sound spelt ch eg: chemist, character
- sh sound spelt ch eg: chef, moustache
- short i sound spelt y eg: gym, mysterious
- -ion (suffix) eg: action, injection
- -ian (suffix) eg: musician, politican
- re- (prefix) eg: rearrange, redecorate
- homophones eg: whether/weather, not/knot
- anti- (prefix) eg: anti-clockwise, antiseptic
