## Safeguarding our children

I am sure many of the children (and adults) will have been fortunate enough to have received lots of exciting new gifts this Christmas. Some of those gifts will I am sure be devices or further opportunities to access the wonderful online world. Whilst the World Wide Web is a fantastic thing, it also has the potential for serious harm. I have been shocked by some of the material and potential dangers I have heard about already this term.

Following on from the Online Safety Workshop held with Year 5 and 6 children, I was shocked to hear how many children are playing/ accessing inappropriate games/ websites outside the recommended age brackets. The school considers this a safeguarding matter and I would urge all parents to monitor their children's activity very closely. The CEOP (Child Exploitation Online Protection) trainer commented on how she can tell, as soon as she walks into a room, whether they are accessing age-inappropriate material from their behaviour. The impact of these games/ sites is really very noticeable and serious. Many of the other users of these sites are adults who are expecting other adults to be co-users and therefore not modifying their behaviour/ language to suit children. It is impossible to 'un-see' or 'un-hear' something and some images and words can play on children's minds for years to come.

I look forward to seeing all Year 5 and Year 6 parents (open to all parents if requested) at our Online Safety parents talk on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January at 9 am in school or 5.30 pm on Teams**.
