**Y3 Trip to Celtic Harmony Camp – Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

As part of our topic “Iron Age to Stone Age” we have arranged to visit Celtic Harmony Camp at Bourne Wood, near Brickendon, Hertfordshire. The Camp is an outdoor education centre and we will spend most of the day outside.

Visitors to Celtic Harmony Camp travel back in time to live and work in harmony with nature to make clothes, food and houses whilst harvesting in a traditional way to improve natural habitats. Celtic Harmony promotes a hands-on approach to learning “Tell me something and I’ll forget it. Show me something and I’ll remember it. Let me do something and I’ll understand it.”

Please make sure the children are wearing, or have with them:

- Warm outdoor clothes. Layers of clothing, warm fleece, outdoor jacket and woolly hat/sun hat as appropriate to weather
- Wellingtons/sturdy shoes
- A Waste-free packed lunch and drinks (not fizzy).

The children are encouraged to dress up for the day but this is not compulsory. Advice on waste-free lunches and costume ideas have been included on the following pages.

We will be leaving school at 8.50am and so your child will need to be at school by 8.40am so that we can take the register and be settled on the coach ready to leave on time. We will be back at school by 3.30pm–3:45pm.

I am hoping that three parent helpers can accompany year 3, who are happy to supervise a group of children alongside a member of staff. If you are free to accompany year 3 on that date, please complete the attached slip and I will contact parents to let them know by Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> October.

The cost of the trip will be £26.15 per child which covers the cost of the coach and the day’s activities. This should be paid via School Money online. Please return the permission slip to the office by Wednesday, 16th October. I appreciate this is an expensive trip but this will be taken in to account when booking any other trips for the year. It really is a great hands-on day and one the children will hopefully remember and enjoy for years to come.
