Year 5 Residential to Woodrow High House, Amersham. Monday, 16th to Wednesday, 18th May 2022

We are excited to inform you that we are planning to take Year 5 on a three-day residential trip to the Woodrow High House Activity Centre in May 2022. We are fortunate to have secured a booking, as it is an extremely popular venue with school groups.

The trip will take place from 16th – 18th May 2022. The cost of the visit will be £195 and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation for two nights, insurance and a full programme of activities.

To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of £45 will be required by Friday, 4th February. We appreciate that this trip is a lot of money and so offer the opportunity to pay the rest in three further instalments of £50 on 25th February, 25th March and 22nd April. Payments can be made online via SchoolMoney.

After a tricky couple of years this trip will provide a great opportunity for our children to develop their teamwork, resilience and perseverance skills, whilst having lots of fun and excitement with their friends. We very much hope all the Year 5 children will be able to attend the trip and encourage you to come and talk to us about any concerns you may have.
