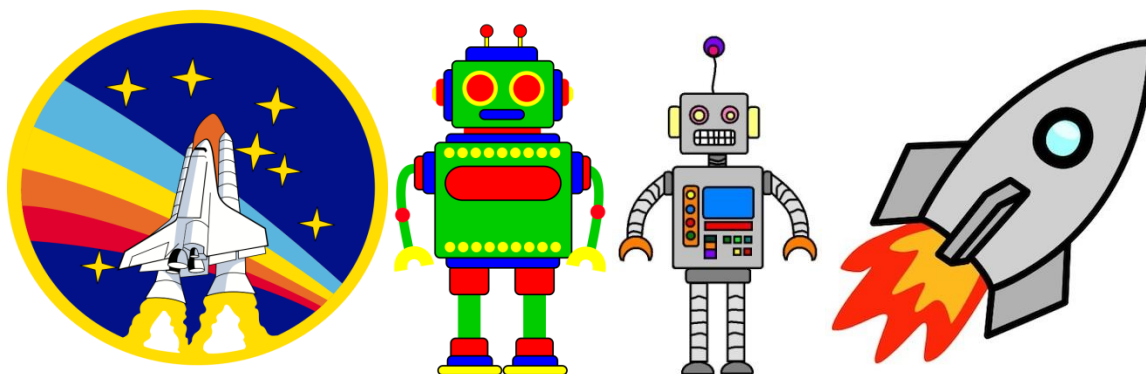
It is a brilliant, community event for the children and a major fundraiser for the school, we raised over £800 last year so we really want you to get involved!

The procession concludes with amusements and entertainment for all of the family in Lowndes Park, with a fairground, bouncy castles, trampolines, a petting farm, face painting and much more. The local mayor will also be attending to award prizes for the best school float.
