ENGLISH Learn at Home packs: Year 4, Week 7

These notes are intended for teachers who are using these materials to continue to teach their class using any form of online file sharing. Often, sharing a personal video clip can be most helpful, as can online chats or messages.

The 'timetable' for this week's teaching and learning is as follows

- Day 1 Provide some teacher input, using the PowerPoint presentation* on adverbials. If children can access this PowerPoint, they will hear the voice-over teaching. Children listen to a reading of Zoo by Anthony Browne. They practise using adverbials and write about a day out.
- Day 2 Children read two opposing opinions about zoos. They practise adverbials, then write a persuasive letter asking a zoo-owner to take good care of animals.
- Day 3 Children write descriptions of foxes. They read a poem about foxes and learn about secret strings. They find these in a second poem about foxes.
- Day 4 Children write descriptions of the sea. They read three poems about the sea, answering reflective questions and writing a comparison.
- Day 5 Children write a description of a storm. They read three poems about storms, finding powerful language and answering questions.

Summary of content

- **Day 1** Listening to a story. Practising using adverbials.
- **Day 2** Reading opinions. Practising adverbials. Writing a letter.
- Day 3 Reading poems. Identifying 'secret strings'.
- **Day 4** Reading poems. Answering questions. Writing a comparison.
- **Day 5** Reading poems. Answering questions.

^{*}PowerPoint presentations are provided. You can use your phone to film yourself going through these on a laptop. OR parents and children can access them at home, preferably in PowerPoint but also as images on a tablet. You can then talk these through. Or you may have a clever online way, perhaps through the school's website, of sharing these presentations with children at home.
