













Rules of the Game:

1. Throw the dice twice.
2. The 1st throw gives you the suffix you must use whilst the 2nd throw gives you the activity: e.g. if you throw a 3 you must think of a word with the suffix -ify. If your 2nd throw is also a 3, the word must then be put into a short rhyme. The resulting rhyme could therefore be:

Once there was an enormous **fly**,
That took a dive into my tea.
'Oh no, I need to **purify**,
Or it will have impurity!'

[I don't intend to take up poetry as that took quite a while to create!]
