Phonics Boom Game 2

Teacher Guidance

Before the session, cut out the game cards and shuffle them into a random order.

Ask the children to sit in a circle and place the shuffled game cards face down in the centre of the circle so that the word on the card cannot be read.

Set a timer for a short period of time. You may wish to start with five minutes but reduce this time as children become confident with the game.

Starting with any child in the circle, ask a child to select a game card. If they are able to read the real or nonsense word on the card correctly, the child gets to keep their card. If they select a card that says BOOM, the child must return all cards they have won back to the centre of the circle.

When time is up or the cards have run out, the child that has won the most game cards wins.
