Hawridge & Cholesbury C of E School Remote Learning Survey 18th January 2021

Following the government's decision on 4th January 2021, Hawridge & Cholesbury C of E School is offering remote learning provision for all children. In order to make any necessary adjustments to ensure that our provision matches the guidance and is manageable for families, we wanted to carry out a short survey.

102 responses were received and the information below reflects the results. One class had a new teacher in January who had relocated to England just days before the new term and was therefore not fully up and running until week 2/3.

The school is aware of a full spectrum of preferences over the type of remote learning on offer. Some families want more live lessons and others feel any more live lessons would be unmanageable especially where families are larger or where parents are also trying to work. The school, therefore aims to offer a varied approach which it hopes will provide a good balance for most families.

Following on from the survey, the Year 6 offer has been increased slightly to ensure children have at least 4 hours work a day.

Please see below a summary of the survey results and a sample of additional comments received.

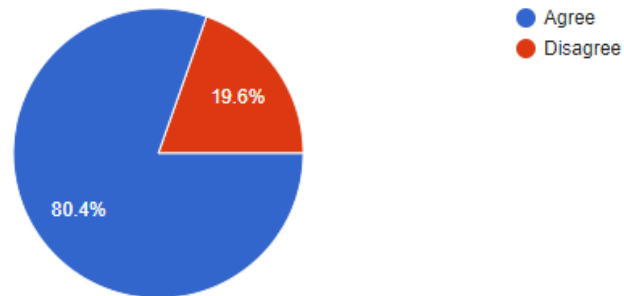


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Survey results

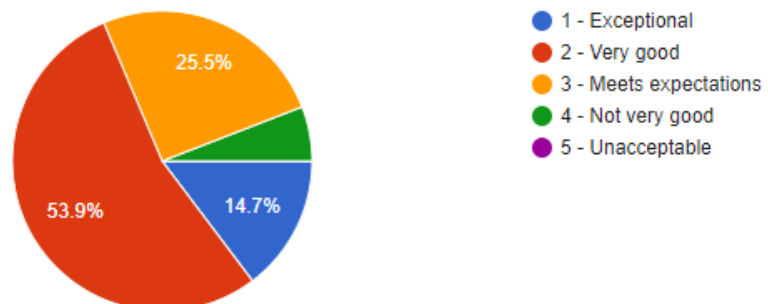
Do you agree with the following statement? The balance of live, recorded and task-based work is working well for my child.

I think my son has plenty of work given to him that he and I can cope with. It's not easy especially as he can get more distracted being at home but I do think this time around is easier than lockdown 1 because of the remote learning involved.

Really appreciate the work up in advance for the week and lots of recorded content makes it easier to juggle school and working from home.

It would be great to have more live lessons because I work full time and it is very difficult to explain tasks if they get stuck and I am in meetings. More live lessons will give them opportunities to ask questions etc

more live lessons would be great if at all possible.

The recorded lessons are working better for us with more benefit. The guided reading one however is great but I think it's because it's with a smaller group of children so there is a lot more interaction.

More interactive online tasks. Interactive lessons or recorded

My daughter enjoys her live lessons and would like more although very difficult juggling other children's needs.

I am much happier now we have Zoom calls and teacher led videos as I feel these are much more engaging than worksheets alone.

My son really has benefitted from teacher and other pupil interaction. His teacher is very thorough on explaining things.
