
### Windmills



We have become rounded pupils by learning lots of different life skills and understanding how our ancestors lived







We were so spiritual showing our family and friends around the museum.






At Woodrow, we enjoyed a spiritual moment as we shared our thoughts and reflections around the campfire.

We were fascinated in Science when we set up experiments to show dissolving and evaporating.




### Year 5
