## Free School Meals & Pupil Premium

Research shows that better food in schools is improving what children eat during the school day, and there's evidence of a clear link between what children eat at lunchtime in school, where they eat it and how they focus with their teachers in the afternoon.

Currently, **all** children in reception, year I and year 2 in state-funded schools in England will be eligible for free school meals. This includes infant pupils in maintained infant and primary schools, free schools, academies, special schools and pupil referral units.

Free school meals are also available to pupils in years 3 and above whose parents receive certain benefits and register using the form over the page. Please return this form to your child's school if you think you qualify.



# Pupil Premium - completing this form could also raise money for your child's school



If your child is in reception, year I or year 2 it is still important to complete this form because registering for free school meals could also raise extra funding (currently £1320 per pupil in primary schools) from central government which can be used in your child's school to raise the attainment of pupils from lower income families and close the gap between them and their peers. This

also applies to children in year 3 up to year 11 (secondary schools currently receive £935 per registered pupil) who register for free school meals.

Furthermore, even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal we would still encourage you to register for free school meals so that their school receives as much funding as possible.

To register for free school meals, including Pupil Premium, please complete the application form over the page and return it to your child's school as soon as possible to avoid delay.

  - ii) have an annual income in excess of £16,190 (Please note that this figure is for April 2015 and that it can change each year).

Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit during the four-week period immediately after their employment ceases, or after they start to work less than 16 hours per week, their children are entitled to free school meals.

Administration for the provision of free school meals is undertaken by Buckinghamshire County Council for those pupils attending an education establishment within Buckinghamshire. This form should be completed and returned to your child's school.
