Sports Day - Thursday 17th July 2025 **EYFS/KS1 - morning / KS2 - afternoon**

Following extensive organisation and planning, we are now excited to confirm the arrangements for this year's Sports Day. We are pleased to invite parents to join us once again this year.

What to wear / bring

- **PE Kit and a T-Shirt in their house colour, Putnams (Red), Orchard (Green) and Dinnets (Blue).** If you are unsure of your child's house, please contact us.
- **A re-fillable water bottle** (water only please). This should be in addition to any lunchtime drink that you might normally supply.
- **A named sun-hat.** The sun at this time of year is strong and it can burn young skin even on an overcast day. The children will be on the school field for a large part of the day.
- **Sun cream must be applied before school** (staff are not permitted to apply sun cream on your behalf). Please contact your child's class teacher should you have any queries.

Timings for the day

- **8.35am** Children will need to be in school at 8.35am to ensure they are ready for the day's events. The main school gates will then be closed at 8.45am.
- **9.15am** The Y5 field gate *will open for EYFS/ KS1 parents* to enter. The PSA will kindly be providing refreshments, so please remember to bring some money. Sports Day will then officially start at 9.45am.
- **11.50pm**, EYFS/ KS1 children will return to their teacher on the playground / classroom.
- **12pm - 12.45pm** We are **inviting all parents (EYFS/KS1 & KS2)** to join their child(ren) on the school field for a **picnic**. Parents who are not already in school should enter via the main gate by the school office.
Please collect your child from their class teacher who will be waiting with them on the school playground. You are then welcome to go and sit with them anywhere on the KS1 school field. If you are unable to attend the lunch, your child will sit in a group with a member of staff. If you would like your child to sit with another family then please complete the Google form, which will be sent out with Lunch/Picnic details next week.
- **12.45pm** All children will go back into school for afternoon registration. EYFS/KS1 parents, who are not staying for the KS2 Sports day, may exit via the main gate.
- **1pm** KS2 sports day will begin.
- **3pm** Children will go back into school to be released by their teachers at the usual times.

How Sports Day will run

The morning and afternoon sessions will run the same. During the first part of the session there will be a selection of 4 stations taking place at any one time. Every child will participate. The second part will consist of running races. Every child will participate in at least one race. Children compete for their houses and points will be awarded in each event. The house with the most points will be our Sports Day winner!
