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Dear Parents

We are excited to share that **The Roving Book Shop** will be returning this year to host a book fair at school on **Tuesday 18th November**. Roving Book Shop are a unique organisation who host a bookshop experience at schools across the country. This event is an exciting opportunity whereby children and parents can browse and purchase books written by a range of authors almost replicating a real life bookshop.

From **8:30am-8:50am** we would like to invite parents/guardians and children to browse and purchase books in the bookshop. The book shop will be set up in the **school hall**. All children will need to return to the classroom for the register at 8:45am, however parents are welcome to stay until 8:50am. **Parents/Guardians will need to sign in via the school office.**

Each class will visit the hall at a designated time during the school day. They will be able to read and appreciate a range of different books and there will be an opportunity to purchase a book of their choice should they wish to during their class slot.

After school the bookshop will remain open from 3:15pm - 4:00pm. If you would like to visit the bookshop, please collect your child as normal and then visit the school hall via the school office entrance.

Payment:

The day before the event, your child will be sent home with a Bookshop Wallet. Your child can use the Bookshop Wallet to pay for books at any point throughout the day. This will contain some guidance around the price of books. From our experience last year, there are some discounts on full price books. The more we spend on books throughout the day enables staff to choose 10 books to add to our school library or class book shelves. Cash and card payment are both available for parents/guardians so that they can purchase books during day or before or after school browsing session.

We hope that this event will help to promote a love for reading for all children by bringing a bookshop experience to school.
