## **PARK SET UP**

Can you help on carnival morning and walk with the procession?

#### **ROAD MARSHALS**

Each school in the carnival needs 4 x able-bodied volunteers to act as road marshals. These people will need to attend an evening briefing on June 12<sup>th</sup> 6.30pm at Chesham Town Hall (creche available too) and then will be assigned a spot next to road closure signs along the carnival route. We may need you to help out with Pedestrian crossings while the event starts in the Park. We are happy to have anyone over 18, aunties, cousins, uncles, grandparents if they'd like to be involved. However children will not be allowed to accompany Marshals on the day.

## **RAFFLE TICKETS**

### **OUR CONCEPT**

We want to try and create a walking 9 ¾ Platform wall (as per example image below) with a magic tinsel curtain you can run through and pretend you are catching the Hogwarts Express!





We need you to help us make up the brick walls with lots of Red/terracotta colour painted brick sized pieces of paper (cut an A4 sheet in half = 2 bricks) and affix to some card – cereal boxes or delivery boxes work well if you affix to the patterned side. Make as many as you like! To make them extra special we'd like you to write or draw on them after you have painted, saying what you would

do if you could do magic! Just a few words like "I would fly to the moon!" because who wouldn't love to be able to do bit of magic! Or cast a spell!!
