

How the ‘target’ column works on the end of term target sheets.

The target set for a child for their next phase of education is based on their prior attainment data. For example, a child in Y1 and Y2 will have their target set based on their end of EYFS data. A child in Y3-6 will have their target set based on their end of key stage 1 data.

This target then remains set and in place during the child’s next phase of education and does not change. We aim for children to at least keep on this trajectory and not fall below. Better still we aim for them to exceed this target. If a target is exceeded, then although the set target on the target sheet remains, we are still working with your child on the higher trajectory. For example, a child who has been set an ‘EXS’ target but has exceeded this and achieved ‘GDS’ will continue to be monitored and developed at a GDS level as shown on this target sheet snippet:
