Dear Parents and Carers,

College Lake Environmental Education Centre, Tring – Friday 4th July 2025

I am delighted to share that our Summer Term trip will be a visit to College Lake on Friday 4th July 2025. College Lake is a nature reserve centred around taking care of wildlife. This links well to our Science topic learning about plants and animals. We will spend time in the Education Centre taking part in a **Habitat Safari**. The Habitat Safari includes three different activities; nature detectives, sensory seekers and pond dippers. We will discover the secrets of different habitats and will be investigating the animals that live in them.

On **Friday 4th July**, the children need to arrive at school at the normal time of 8:35 as we will be leaving promptly at 9am. We will return to school before the end of the school day so the children can be collected at the normal time of 3:15pm. School will provide a school packed lunch but please ensure that your child has plenty of water for the day. Children need to wear wellington boots or sturdy footwear and outdoor clothing comprising long sleeves and trousers, waterproofs, jumpers, hat and gloves or sun hats and sun cream (according to the weather).
